Evergreen Trees

Arborvita *Thuja occ.cvs*

An upright evergreen used for narrow screens or accent plantings.

~ **American Pyramidal**

The fastest growing variety, this plant reaches a size of 20'T 6'W.

~ **Nigra**

This dark green plant grows to 12'T x 4'W.

The Techny is greenest in Winter.

Yew

~ **Japanese Yew** *Taxus x media cvs.*

- **Brownii**

Similar to the Densiformus, the Brownii is slower growing, and its foliage is less thick. Grows 6'T x 8'W.

- **Densiformus**

This yew, frequently used in landscapes, can be trimmed to many different shapes. Grows 2-4'T x 4-6'W.

- **Hicksi**

This upright yew, which grows from 4-15'T, is best used for tall hedges.

Colorful Flowering Shrubs

Barberry *Berberis t. cvs.*

Available in many colors and sizes, the Barberry makes a great addition to your landscape.

~ **Crimson Pygmy**

This slow growing plant stays a maroon color all season. Grows to 3'T x 3'W.

~ **Golden Japanese**

This plant has golden leaves in sun, or lime-colored in shade. Grows 2'T x 3'W.

Cistina Purple Plum

Prunus x cistena

This vase shaped shrub has purple leaves and pink blooms. Grows 7-10'T.

Cotoneaster *Coton. spp.*

The arching limbs of this plant spread horizontally bearing small leaves and red berries.

Euonymus *Euon. fort. cvs.*

A tiny shrub available in several varieties.

~ **Emerald Gaiety**

Colorful Flowering Shrubs

Hydrangea *Hydr. spp.*

Tolerant of sun or shade depending on cultivar. We have several varieties available.

~ **Lemon Wave**

Variiegated leaves make this shrub attractive even when not in bloom. Grows 3'T.

~ **Nikko Blue** *H. mac. 'N.Bl.'*

Depending on the pH balance of the soil, this variety produces blue to pink flowers. Grows 4-6'T.

~ **Oak Leaf** *H. quercifolia*

This plant has oak like leaves and has cluster flowers in early summer. Grows to 6'T x 6'W.

This variety is a larger shrub form producing white flower clusters from mid to late summer on. Grows 6'T.

Lilac

~ **Common Lilac** *Syringa vulgaris*

Large shrub bearing fragrant flowers in May.

Flowers may be white, lavender, magenta, or blue depending on cultivar. Grows 8-15'T x 6-12'W.

Pink Flowering Almond

Prunus glaudulosa

A vase shaped shrub with double pink blossoms in spring.

Potentilla *Poten.fr.cvs.*

With wispy foliage and available with pink, yellow or white blooms, this shrub has flowers most of the summer. Grows 3'T x 3'W.

Rose of Sharon *Hib.syr.cvs.*

A tall vase shaped shrub with carnation like blooms in late summer, this shrub is available in white, pink, red, and violet. Grows to 8'T.

Serviceberry *Amelanchier spp.*

This large multi-shaped shrub has both blooms and edible fruit. Grows to 12'T.
